LOCATION

On the Northern Coast of the Dominican Republic 15 minutes from Sosua. 15 miles/23 km from Puerto Plata International Airport; 157 miles/250 km from "Las Americas" Airport in Santo Domingo (approx. 3:30 hrs)

HOTEL DESCRIPTION

The Viva Wyndham Tangerine hotel is located in a 10,000 m2 tourist complex with 110 m of beautiful beachfront.

It has 11 buildings, a lovely theatre and a swimming pool where the guests can enjoy daily animation with merengue and salsa classes, aerobics and much more...

Christopher Columbus discovered the island of Hispaniola on December 5, 1492. Located in the center of the Caribbean Sea, it is the second of the Greater Antilles, preceded by Cuba in the first position. The island is divided into two nations: the Republic of Haiti and the Dominican Republic.

The Dominican Republic was born on February 27, 1844. Independence was declared in Puerta del Conde at the beginning of Calle El Conde where the flag was first raised.

CLIMATE

The coastal zone is blessed with warm, tropical weather while the central region is somewhat cooler.

LANGUAGE

The official language of the Dominican Republic is Spanish. It is common to find people who speak English, French, Italian and German because of the country's tourist importance.

CURRENCY

The legal currency is the Dominican Peso. It fluctuates based on the value of the American Dollar being subject to international market forces.

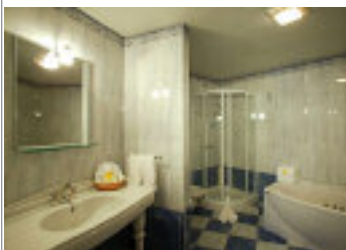
TRANSPORT

The country has eight airports: Internacional de las Américas y Herrera in Santo Domingo; Punta Águila, Internacional la Romana and Punta Cana in the Eastern region; María Montez in Barahona; Gregorio Luperon in Puerto Plata; and Del Cibao in Santiago de los Caballeros.

The main highways all start in Santo Domingo connecting the whole country: Duarte Highway that connects the South to the North and East and West; Las Américas Highway that connects the South with the Southeast; and Sánchez Highway that connects the South and the Southwest.

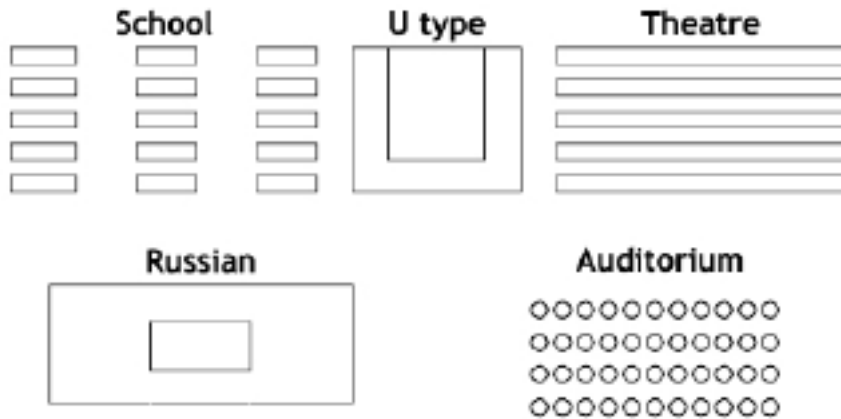
